- b. The ASO may deny the requested accommodation if it is unreasonable.
  - i. An accommodation is unreasonable if it:
    - 1. Imposes an undue financial and/or administrative burden;
    - 2. Fundamentally alters SJC housing policies;
    - 3. Poses a direct threat to the health and safety of others or would cause
