## **Appeals**

Appeals of reasonable accommodation decisions, including removals of ESAs, are heard by the Vice President of Student Services. The office is located at Rm. 4122 Education Services Building and the phone number is 505-566-3400

Appeals of the Vice President of Student Services' decision must be made to the Section 504 Title II Coordinator who handles complaints of discrimination, harassment and retaliation, including, but not limited to, the accommodation process or denial of an appeal of an accommodation decision. The Assistant Director of Human Resources/Officer of Equity, Diversity and Inclusion is the designated Section 504/Title II Coordinator.
